

Checklist for House Cleaners



General Tasks:

- Inspect the entire house for any areas that need special attention or repairs.
- Gather all necessary cleaning supplies and equipment before starting.

Living Room:

- Dust all surfaces, including shelves, tables, picture frames, and electronics.
- Vacuum and/or sweep the floors, and mop hard surfaces.
- Clean mirrors and glass surfaces.
- Vacuum and fluff sofas and cushions.
- Empty and clean ashtrays (if applicable).

Kitchen:

- Clean and disinfect countertops, backsplash, and sink.
- Clean exterior and interior of all appliances (microwave, oven, refrigerator, etc.).
- Wipe down cabinets, handles, and knobs.
- Empty and clean the trash can.
- Sweep and mop the floors.

Bathrooms:

- Clean and sanitize the sink, faucet, and countertops.
- Scrub and disinfect the toilet, including the handle and base.
- Clean the shower/tub, tiles, and glass doors.
- Replace used towels with clean ones.
- Sweep and mop the floors.

Bedrooms:

- Change bed linens and make the beds.
- Dust all surfaces, including furniture and decorations.
- Vacuum and/or sweep the floors, and mop hard surfaces.
- Organize clothes and personal items.

Dining Room:

- Dust all surfaces, including the dining table and chairs.
- Vacuum and/or sweep the floors, and mop hard surfaces.
- Wipe down cabinets and storage units.

Hallways and Entryways:

- Dust all surfaces, including shelves and decorations.
- Vacuum and/or sweep the floors, and mop hard surfaces.
- Clean entryway mirrors and glass if applicable.
